Job Duties:

- Ability to work with little to no supervision; work as a team with one other Program Leader.
- Report mileage, receipts, timesheets and program attendance on a regular basis.
- Travel to various playground sites within the City of Saskatoon instructing fun soccer drills to children ages 4 to 12 by following a set playground program schedule.

Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must have played some soccer and enjoy the game.
- Experience coaching and/or working with children.
- Mandatory completion of certifications prior to start date:
 1. NCCP Fundamentals ~ Theory portion of the clinic can be completed online and completed by Mon Apr 27, 2026. The on-field clinic for FUNdamentals will take place on Fri May 1, 2026 (6-9pm) ~ expense is reimbursed upon completion of course and submission of receipts.
 2. Respect in Sport, Making Headway, Rule of Two, and Emergency Action Plan – Four free online modules.
 3. Making Ethical Decisions - Online clinic and evaluation - expense is reimbursed upon completion of course and submission of receipt.
 4. First Aid and CPR ‘C’ ~ expense is reimbursed upon completion of course and submission of receipt.
- NCCP Learn to Train coach certification an asset but not required.
- Post-secondary student returning to school in the fall is preferred but not required.
- Criminal record check with vulnerable sector.
- Valid driver’s license and vehicle for transportation is required either from you or your co-worker.
- Ability to commit to full duration of program July 2 – August 20, 2026. First day of employment begins at 9:00 AM on Thur July 2 for a brief orientation and equipment distribution.
